### *A modest update in the absence of Fr. Chris*

This is just to reassure people that the matter of the Parish Centre and the proposed new kitchen have not slipped off the agenda. The present hiatus is an inevitable result of Fr. Chris's absence on his long Retreat and sabbatical until the end of next month. Since nothing to do with property is ever straightforward, it proved impossible to come to any watertight conclusions before he went away.

That said, it is hoped that by the time he returns Fr Chris will find awaiting him sufficiently clear and thought-through proposals for the Parish Centre so that he might have something to bring to the Parish Meeting on 7<sup>th</sup> December. It is intended that these proposals will honor the hard work and generosity of all who arranged and have contributed to the new kitchen project. The shape of the proposals remain to be seen but are in process of being drawn up.

You will be glad to know that Fr. Chris is working on the clear basis that the total loss of use of the Centre by the parish is not an acceptable outcome.
