Letting God loose this Advent -1 What about You?

One of the many surprises I encountered when I came to St George's last year as a newly-minted Roman Catholic priest was being told by people that they had never before heard this or that Catholic teaching or that they had had no serious faith formation since their First Holy Communion, in the days of the Latin Mass and *mantillas*. Then there were the hints about a perhaps dry but dutiful devotional life that didn't seem to bring about a relationship with Jesus or with the Father. What was I to make of it?

Meanwhile, Pope Francis was behaving like a genuine human being and not like some sort of 'plaster pope', coming close to us, risking making mistakes and daring to tell 'outsiders' that they are really *insiders* because God's Church is for "Everyone! Everyone! Everyone!" – and not just for those the clergy said were good enough. The Pope even made women and laymen equal voting members of the Synod of Bishops along with the cardinals, bishops and big-wigs. God seemed to be up to something new!

What might it have to do with you (yes, **you**)?

In Advent, I shall lead four, weekly, Sunday morning sessions between the masses, on how to *experience yourself* as someone who knows God personally and who is being called to an always deeper sense of your identity in Christ along with everyone else at St George's and beyond.

Consider coming to the four sessions – missing one is no excuse for not coming to the others! – to see what God might have in store for you. Begin by asking yourself, here and now:

How do I feel as I read about this?

Does anything stir in me that might be looking for some deeper sense of my faith?
